Dear Junior Class Student of 2012 & Parents:

As Junior Class Officers, we would like to welcome all the juniors to the new school year and explain the Junior Class' responsibilities regarding fund raising. This year, the junior class will raise funds to defray the costs of Prom 2011, Homecoming 2011, and Graduation 2012. Prom will not be until May, but we have a lot of work to do before then.

Since the Junior Class is in charge of raising a large amount of money (not only for prom but also for our own homecoming and graduation next year) each junior is asked to do his or her part. In order to receive an invitation to prom each junior must sell a minimum of 10 tickets for each of the chicken barbeques and participate in doing the following:

**(Ways to work off junior class fees) Working take off \$20.00/Desserts take off \$10.00**

Each junior class members beginning balance:	<b>\$100.00</b>
Having your parents work at 1 varsity boy's football game (selling 50/50 tickets)	-(\$20.00)
You working 2 varsity boys basketball games (selling cake raffle tickets)	-(\$40.00)
Bringing in baked goods for the boys varsity basketball games raffle	-(\$10.00)
Providing a baked good for the chicken barbeques	-(\$10.00)
Working at one or both of the chicken barbeques	<u>-\$20.00</u>
Total fees due would be:	<b>= \$ 0.00</b>

If you choose to work more than 2 games, we will take \$20.00 off your bill for each additional game you work. If you bring baked goods for the chicken barbeque, we will take off \$10.00 for one baked item you contribute. If you sign up and choose not to work your games or chicken BBQ's, or bring cakes you will be charged an additional \$20.00 and \$10.00 respectively for each game you do not work or cake you do not bring. **The maximum amount owed by you would be \$100.00. This fee will be added to your school fees and is your responsibility to pay prior to your graduation.**

Sign up sheets will be available during the lunch periods and announcements will be made concerning your class or projects. **We will be holding a Harlan's Chicken Barbeque Dinner in the fall in the auditoria before the last home football game from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m.** Each junior must sell a minimum of 10 tickets for each barbeque. The junior that sells the most tickets will be admitted into prom free of charge. Workers and desserts are needed for that night, so sign up now. Last year we sold 556 dinners. Let's beat that record! Forms will be available soon for you to sell tickets.

Money for prom is not due until March; there will be more on that later.

If you have any questions, ask one of the officers or one of the junior class advisors. The advisors are Darlene Whitley, Melany Knippen and Judy Roberson. It takes all of us working together to make a successful prom. Please do your part to make everything go smoothly, so that we have a good prom and homecoming our senior year.
