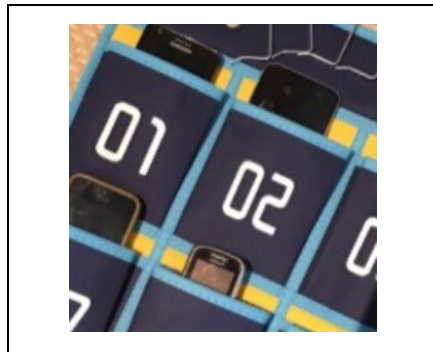

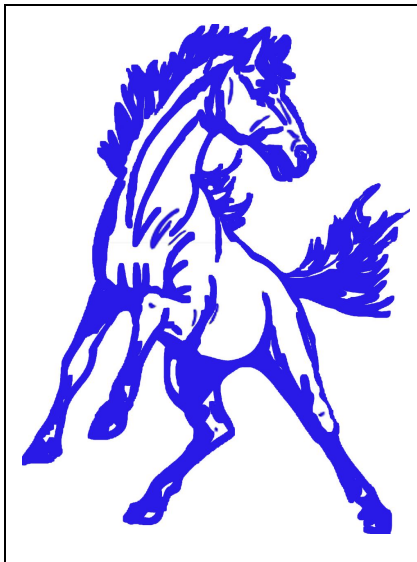
## Grades on Schoology!

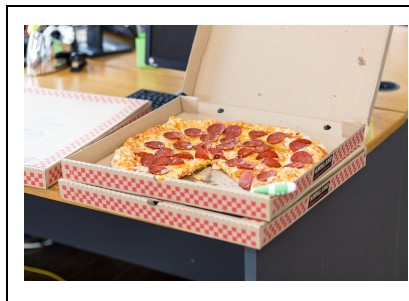

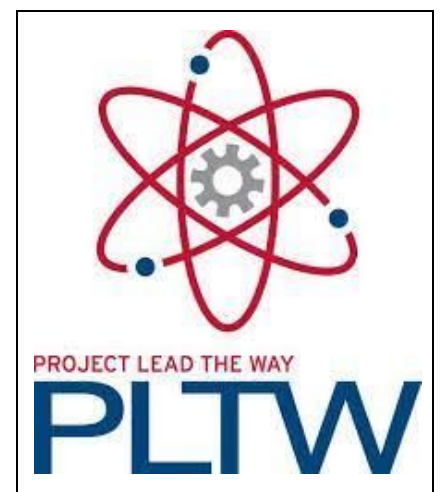
## Wild Mustangs After School Guidelines
