Lima Branch of the American Association of University Women 2020 Scholarship Application for Baccalaureate or Graduate Degree

To qualify for an AAUW Lima Branch Scholarship, an applicant must be female, a graduate of an accredited high school, plan to enroll, or be enrolled in an accredited college or university for the Fall 2020 quarter/semester, and meet one of the following two qualifications:

- 1. If studying for a baccalaureate degree, she must be a graduate of an Allen County, Ohio, high school.
- 2. If studying for a graduate degree, she need not be a graduate of an Allen County, Ohio, high school, but she must presently have her primary residence in Allen County.

No applicant may receive more than two scholarships from AAUW Lima Branch.

All scholarship recipients are required to volunteer for ten hours assisting with book fair preparations after June 1 and prior to the first semester/quarter payment of scholarship money.
